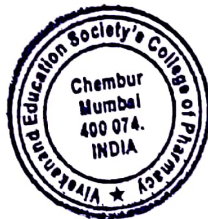

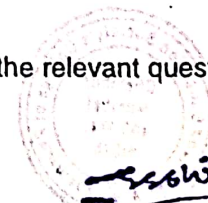

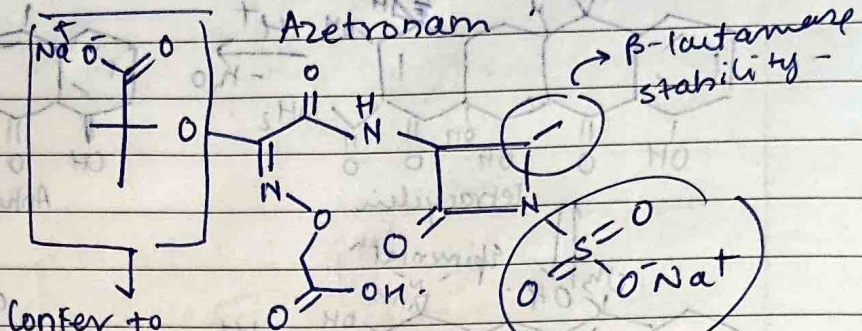

→ Prodrugs are molecules that get converted to the active form of the drug in vivo, these molecules are inactive or atleast a 1000 times less active than the parent drug.

01 Prodrugs are bipartite or tripartite. Bipartite prodrugs are molecules in which there is a main drug and a carrier.

The carrier is the inactive portion that confers certain advantages to the drug molecule.

For Ex: Chloramphenicol palmitate is a bipartite prodrug and is used as it has decreased bitterness and thus increased patient compliance.

Tripartite prodrugs are molecules that have 3 parts the main drug, linker and the carrier.

The reason tripartite prodrugs are developed is due to the reason that a linker is needed sometimes to enter the size of drug for example to show steric effect. Thus the molecule showing steric effect can't be too close to main molecule. Thus a linker is added.

For Ex: Ampicillin and sulbactam ~~are~~ form a prodrug that's called Sultamicillin; this is tripartite.
