The NISP awareness programme was organized at VES College of Pharmacy, Mumbai on 19th December 2020.

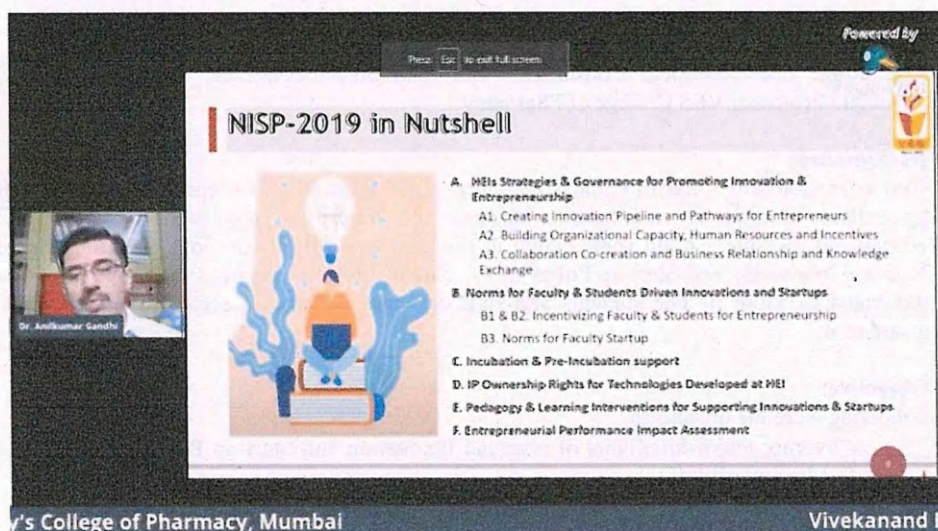

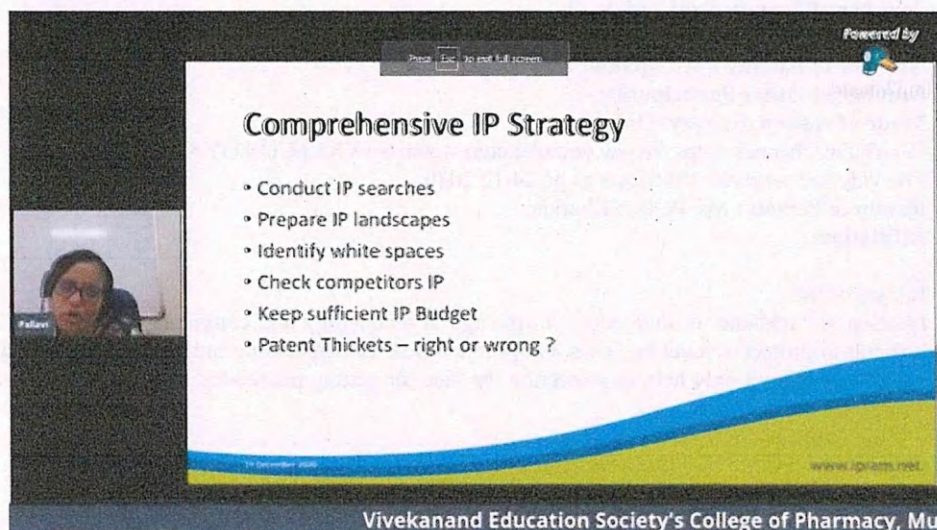
The resource person, in a simplistic language elaborated in patents. What kind of the product can be and can't be patented. She elaborated on what can be done with such a patent like, create, sell, buy, license, pass it under a will and prohibiting production by

others. After preliminary introduction she shifted focus on the main title of presentation with differentiating different types of IPRs. She talked on comprehensive IP strategy. Like having asset-up of hiring legal support, identifying various vendors and suppliers, exploring other IPs which may be needed, exploring finances and grants, signing NDA at earlier stage, making proper agreements and putting proper confidentiality clauses.

The comprehensive IP strategy will involve through IP searches, preparing IP landscapes, identifying loop holes, check competitor IP, having enough IP budget. Having company registration and having a www domain are also part of the process. She elaborated the concepts with example of SmithKline Vs Watson for copyright infringement. She also talked on pro and cons of protecting design with the help of Apple phone vs Samsung.

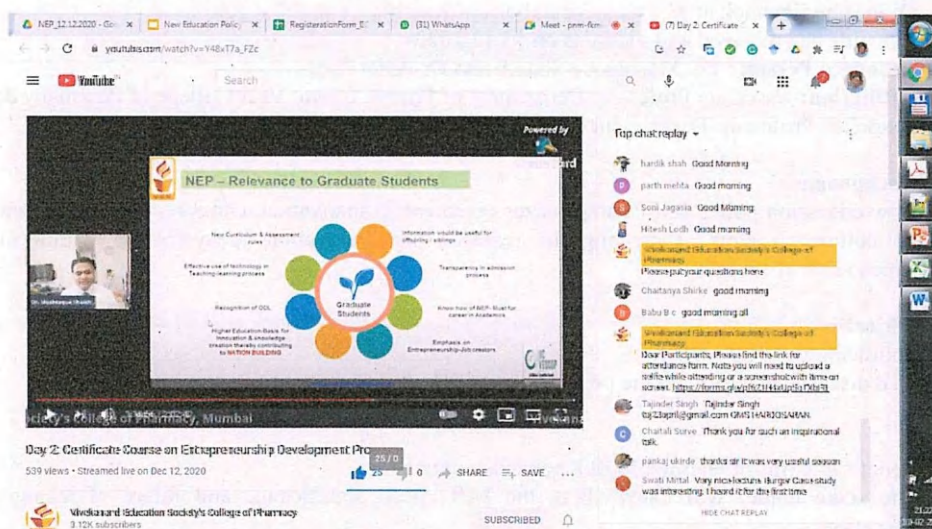
The NEP awareness programme was organized at VES College of Pharmacy, Mumbai on 12th December 2020.

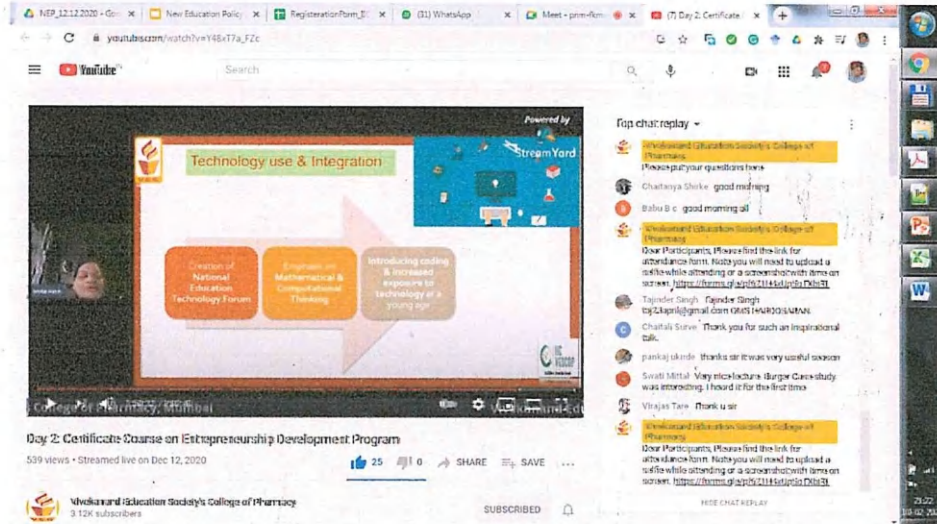

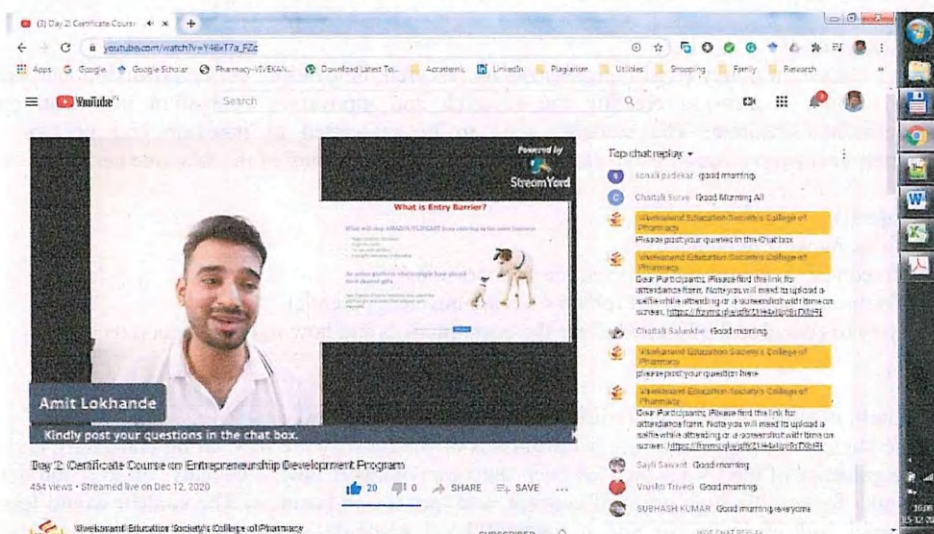
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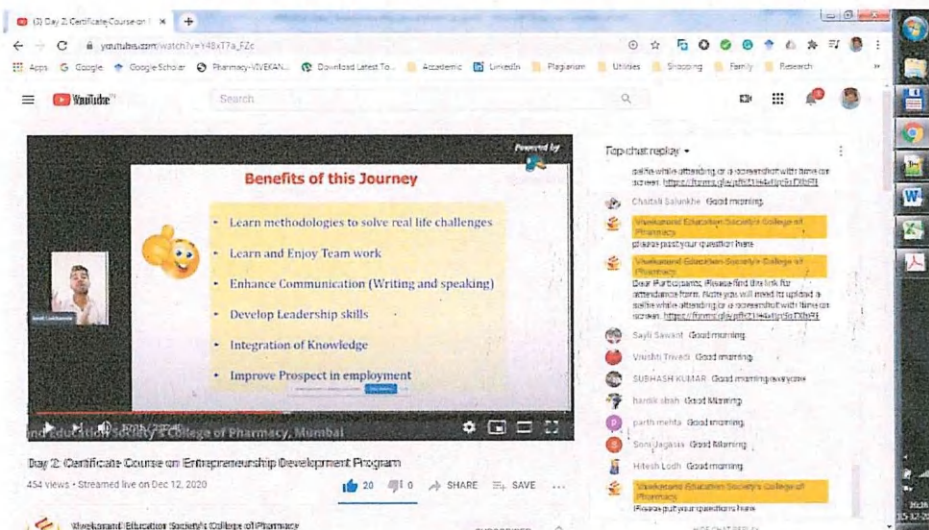
The patent awareness programme was organized at VES College of Pharmacy, Mumbai on 12th December 2020.

He also discussed all these points with a business idea of wedding gift. To further elaborate he also explained another example of CocaCola. For a scalable business example he compared Infosys with Microsoft. He analyzed what you call a good idea and what you call a bad one. Later he moved to Business model canvas like, resources, activities, partners, value perception, channels, clients, cost and revenues. Elaborated these ideas with example of Amazon. A very interesting comparison of Student life vs Entrepreneurship was made. He also discussed the advantages of taking the journey of entrepreneurship.

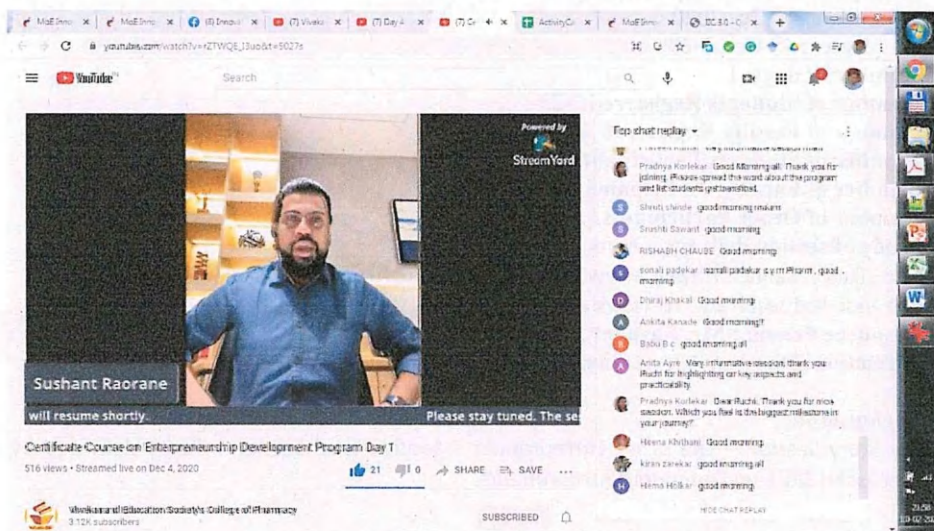
The Entrepreneurship Development programme was organized at VES College of Pharmacy, Mumbai on 4th December 2020.

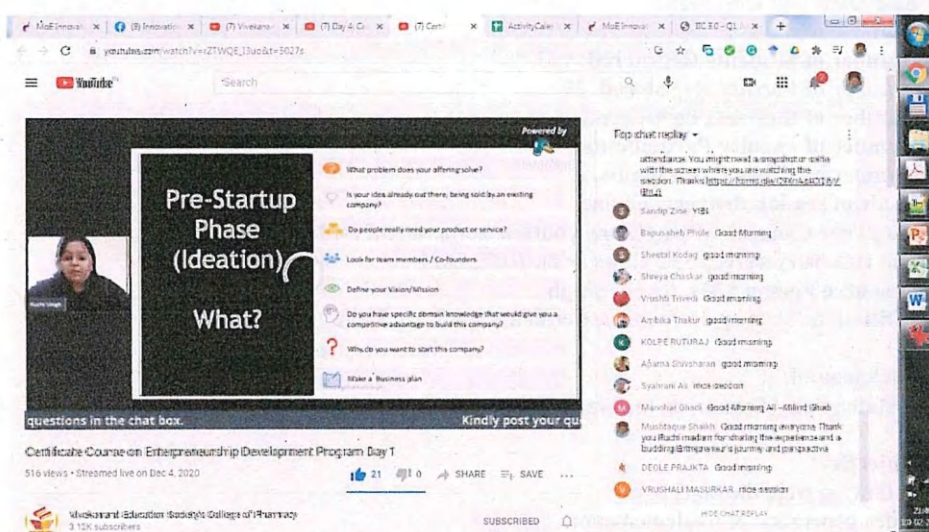

Mr Sunil Patil spoke about how inventions could help to boost economic and technological developments in the country. He explained how patents can also be registered and assigned just the same way as any other immovable property and stressed its importance in the light of new agreements such as TRIPS and WTO.

He spoke on other forms of IPRs like copyright, trade mark, geographical indications, etc. He gave many examples of how very simple inventions gave the people advantage in their daily lives and also benefited the inventor financially. This was followed by a question-answer session.

Day 2: The patent awareness programme was organized at VES College of Pharmacy, Mumbai on 7th November 2020. About 60 participants including students and faculties participated in the programme.

Mr Sunil Patil spoke on the "Patenting System in India" In his lecture, he spoke on different forms of IPRs with suitable examples, with specific reference to patents. Mr Patil explained the present system of patenting in India and also gave necessary details on various steps involved in filing patents (like provisional and final specifications, patent examination, publication, opposition etc), time required for each of the steps and fees to be paid at different stages. He also emphasized on "Novelty and Inventiveness in Patents" "Copyright Management". He explained why novelty and inventiveness are essential for grant of patents and how these are decided during patent examination. He discussed extensively on copyright issues and the litigations arising out of them. Further, these technical sessions were followed by question-answer session in which questions related to technicalities of patents (like patentability of innovations etc) and patenting procedures were posed by the participants and were duly clarified by the speakers.

Day 3: The patent awareness programme was organized at VES College of Pharmacy, Mumbai on 11th November 2020. About 60 participants including students and faculties participated in the programme.

Mr Sunil Patil gave an overview of the present system of patenting in India with details on various steps involved in filing patents (like provisional and final specifications, patent examination, publication, opposition etc), time required for each of the steps and fees to be paid at different stages. He also gave some interesting data patent applications filed, patents granted in various patent offices in India. He also explained about "Patent Information and

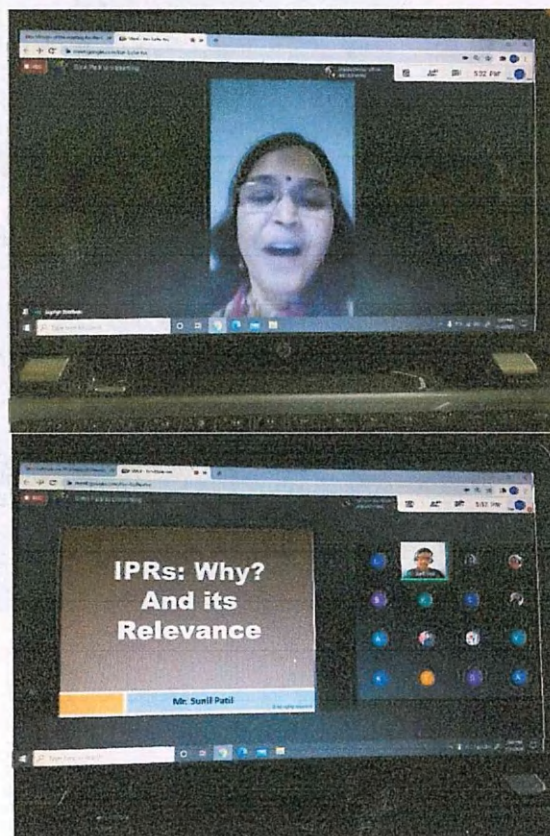


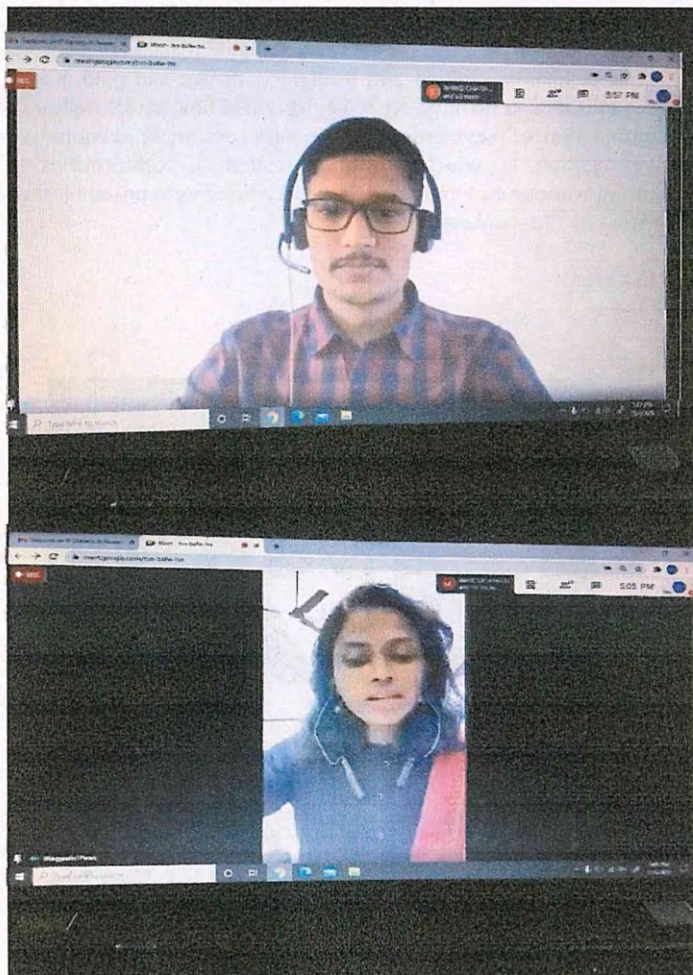
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its access". He spoke on how novelty and inventiveness are essential for consideration for granting patents and also how these are decided through exhaustive patent searches. He gave details of various databases - Indian and foreign, with free and paid access - available for patent searching to establish novelty. Also, he explained how patent search is done using key words and combination of keywords. Further, these technical sessions were followed by question-answer session in which questions related to technicalities of patents (like patentability of innovations etc) and patenting procedures were posed by the participants and were duly clarified by the speakers.

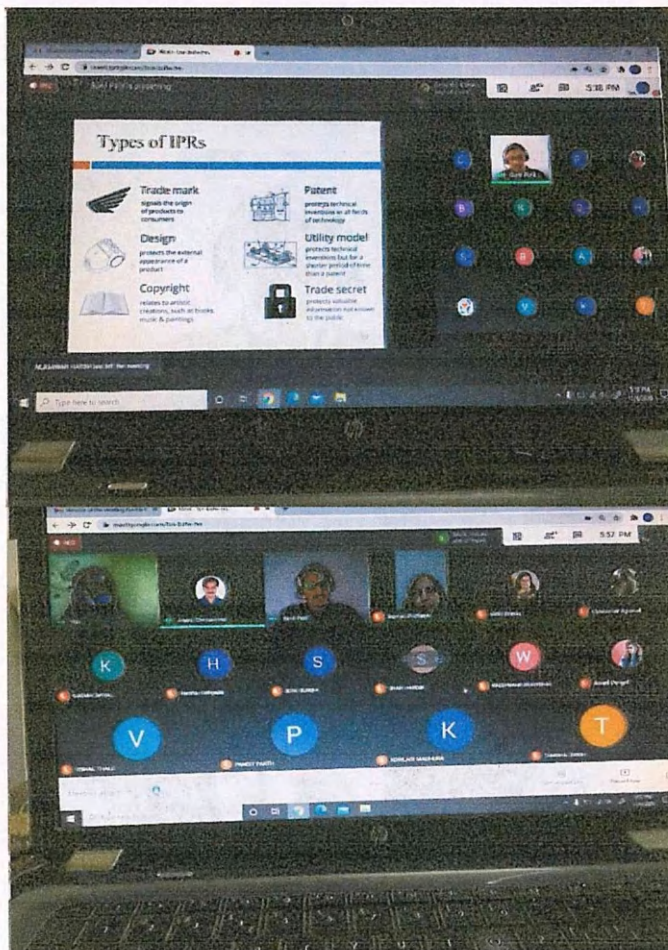


Report Field Visit to Tinkering Lab
