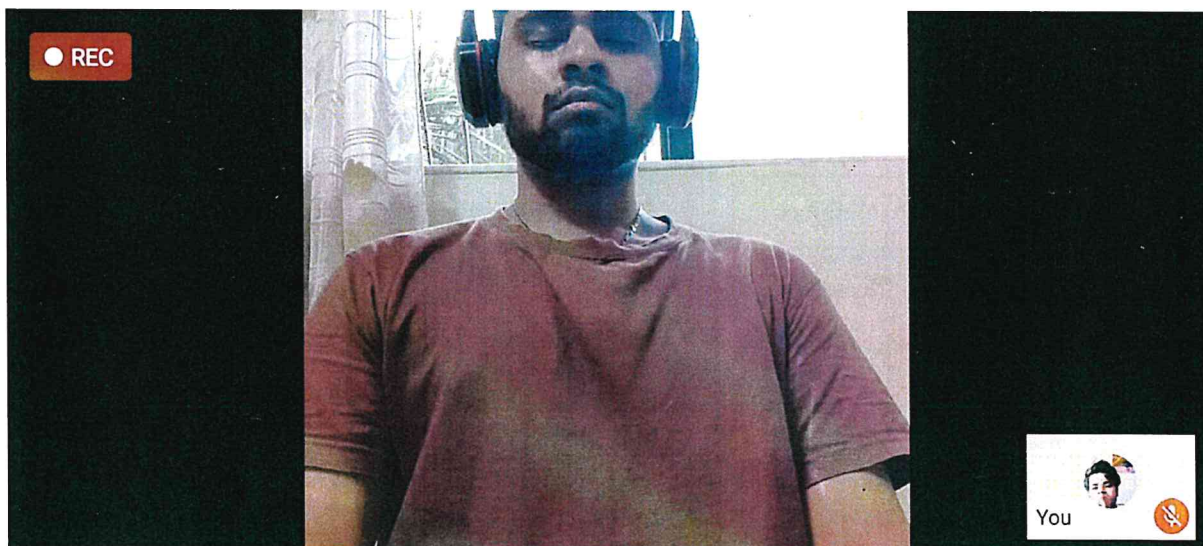

**Q1: Since your area is pharmaceuticals, would you like to tell us how one can work and grow in this field and what all different areas can one explore?**  
**ANS:** Pharmaceuticals is the most wanted area, I would say, for post-graduation after B.Pharm. Because, after graduation when you enter the job market there is a lot of research and production in the pharmaceuticals area. Pharmaceutical deals with a variety of drug-delivery systems and their designing. Designing drug-delivery systems is a vital part of research in pharmaceuticals. Consequently, this area has a lot of opportunities when it comes to research or establishing a career in it. It matters if you take a sincere interest in that area, but I would say that if you want to pursue education after Bachelors, this is one of the most growing fields.

**Q2: Throughout your course of work with and about the novel drug-delivery systems, what garnered your interest? Anything specific?**

**ANS:** I have worked on Novel Drug-Delivery Systems in my Masters and am currently working with the same in my Ph.D. Recently, the focus has shifted from polymer to lipid-based drug-delivery system. The motive of the research is to develop

something safe and effective. The polymer is a foreign molecule. So whenever it is injected into the body it is bound to show side effects. So efforts were taken to design something that will prove to be body friendly.

During the course of it, lipids caught attention. Lipids when used as carrier molecules show least side effects since they form a vital part of our body and will show therapeutic activity. Lipid-based drug-delivery system has various subtypes and I have worked upon SNEDDS (Self-Nanoemulsifying Drug-Delivery System) and I'm working on Solid Lipid Nanoparticle (SLN) and Nanostructure Lipid Carrier (NLC).

Mucosal administration, SNEDDS undergo self-emulsification process to form nanoparticulate drug-delivery system in presence of water in stomach. Basically, a powder or a pre-mix is being administered, which will convert into a nanoparticle and show its effect.

This brilliant concept of administering drugs was what instantly caught my eye and garnered my interest in it.

**Q3: In which areas are you involved in research, at the moment?**

**ANS:** I'm working under the guidance of Dr. Supriya Shidhaye in the area of Cancer research. We are developing a drug-delivery system for a herbal drug, which is not proven to treat cancer yet. We're working on proving it to have anti-cancer properties. Because a natural source will show the most therapeutic effect and least side effects on healthy cells, making it desirable for the patients.

**Q4: What new technologies are available for efficient drug release or promoting new drug delivery efficiency?**

**ANS:** As mentioned earlier, pharmaceuticals is all about the drug-delivery technologies. As far as new technologies are concerned, I would say, targeting the delivery system to the affected area is a lot worked upon right now. Numerous targeting agents are being used to follow acid.

When tumour cells are growing they have a high nutritional requirement as compared to normal cells and consequently the receptors for such nutrients are over-expressed. So, the folic acid that is being consumed, will mostly be used-up by the tumour cells to meet their requirements. Hence, after incorporating folic acid in delivery systems, they can reach the tumour cells where they take up folic acid and as a result of this, the nanoparticle is also taken up which contains the drug and will kill the cells eventually. Since this is a part of our body, it is bio-compatible as well. Apart from this, numerous other receptors get over-expressed on cancer cells that the researchers are trying to identify. They're performing isolation of gene sequence and trying to predict the receptors and design the targeting molecules accordingly.

Another one is, a magnetic delivery system where they inject magnetic particles with delivery systems in the body and from outside they move a magnet all over the body so wherever there's a tumour, the delivery system will get directed there and will effectively release the drugs.

**Q5: Compared to the primary and secondary spreading during which SARS-Cov-2 was transmitted from animal to human and from human to human, has the transmission rate increased and has the pathogenicity decreased?**

**ANS:** Transmission rate has increased from animal to human. As we can see, over the months, the total cases have been decreasing despite opening up various aspects of normal life and businesses. When there was a lockdown, the cases kept growing, fourfold but after opening up, even though people resumed their work, the cases kept decreasing. I would say that the pathogenicity is decreasing owing to the immunity that people have developed over a time where they are immune after exposure to such an infection.

**Q6: What challenges do you feel that the field of microbiology will face in the future and what can we, as pharmacists, do to contribute towards it?**

**ANS:** I believe microbial resistance is one of the most difficult challenges that we have to face. Microbial community is advancing with us. Since we are using stronger antimicrobial agents, the community is getting genetically modified and developing resistance. Consequently, they're growing stronger. I would say, the way we use antimicrobial agents, without rules and regulations, is a contributing factor to it. The protocols regarding how much, which and in what

situation, to use the agents should be stringent. As pharmacists, we should guide the patients regarding the appropriate usage of the antibiotics and create awareness about the same.

**Q7: Which are the current applications of nanotechnology in pharmaceutical formulations?**

**ANS:** Nanotechnology has widespread applications in formulation. The most important of all is solubility enhancement. Over some time, newer molecules are being developed and a trend is observed that they are water-insoluble. There are BCS classes of molecules, BCS class 1 molecules are water-soluble and bioavailable. Class 2 molecules are water-insoluble but lipid-soluble. So, we are getting to see more of Class 2 drugs. Affinity for water is an important aspect of the solubility of drugs in the body. Nanotechnology aids the break down the particle in a nano form, in which the absorption is improved.

Another application is designing a sustained-release system. For instance, we have a drug which is being incorporated into the lipidic nanoparticle which then is injected intravenously and circulated in the entire body. Before elimination, it will keep on circulating based on its size. So, if it is bigger, the macrophages will eat them up, but if it is in a nano form, it will escape the first line immunity barriers and will continuously circulate and release the drug.

Polymer and lipid both help to develop a sustained-release system which in turn reduces the frequency of intravenous injections as in the case of cancer patients.

One more example is designing targeted systems, around the tumour area, there is angiogenesis (formation of a network of blood vessels). Those veins have wider

angiogenesis (formation of a network of blood vessels). Those veins have wider openings and hence the nano-sized particles can easily squeeze themselves out of the wide openings. This is known as Enhanced Permeation and Retention (EPR) effect. This suggests that it will easily permeate the tumour area due to angiogenesis but will not get eliminated because the lymphatic drainage is blocked due to a lot of waste and they can't form a dense network, causing the drug molecule to get trapped in the tumour. These systems prove to be advantageous since they're not rigid and can be easily modified and customized.
