Outcomes	This celebration was thoroughly enjoyed and loved by the teachers as well as the students. The teachers were extremely delighted to see the great organization of the celebration.



Cancer is a disease so critical, that the only hope is stem cell therapy. Understanding this need of the hour, the Marrow Donor Registry India (MDRI) gave VES College of Pharmacy an opportunity to partner with them so that more people register as marrow donors, and subsequently more patients who desperately need access to stem cell transplant from a voluntary donor, have an access to it.
