Outcomes	This celebration was thoroughly enjoyed and loved by the teachers as well as the students. The teachers were extremely delighted to see the great organization of the celebration.



Outcomes	The event served its purpose of spreading knowledge about the constitution of India. It was indeed enlightening and insightful for everyone.




Objectives	The purpose of the event was to celebrate the birth anniversary of the iron man of India Sardar Vallabhhai Patel.

Outcomes	It was a successful event, students actively participated and got a chance to read much more about Sardar Patel.



ROUND 2 - TALENT ROUND: Each one was asked to showcase their best talent.


ROUND 3 - QUESTION-ANSWER ROUND: The contestants had to pick a chit at random and had to use their wit and humour to answer the given question.




