Following points of agenda were discussed.


**Review of student's grievances received if any and whether the grievance has been redressed. No formal grievances were reported by students during the Odd Semester of the Academic Year 2025-26.**

However, certain common concerns raised through the Mentoring Cell were discussed in detail and appropriate resolutions were arrived at, as summarized below:

1. **Students requested reconsideration of the current policy that restricts those opting for higher studies from participating in placement interviews.**  
The matter was discussed with the committee members. It was resolved that students who apply for higher studies shall be permitted to appear for placement interviews only if they are rejected for admission to higher studies. This decision ensures fairness while maintaining the integrity of both processes.
2. **Students requested that the in-plant training for ACKVK students be scheduled during the Christmas or summer vacation period**  
It was informed to the students that in-plant training had already been conducted during the Christmas vacation, addressing the concern to a reasonable extent.
3. **Students suggested reducing the number of assignment questions and requested that the question bank, PPTs, blueprints, and application-based questions be shared and discussed in advance to facilitate examination preparation.**  
The concern was communicated to all faculty members through the Program Committee and Staff Meetings. Faculty were advised to share relevant study materials in advance to facilitate effective learning and examination readiness.



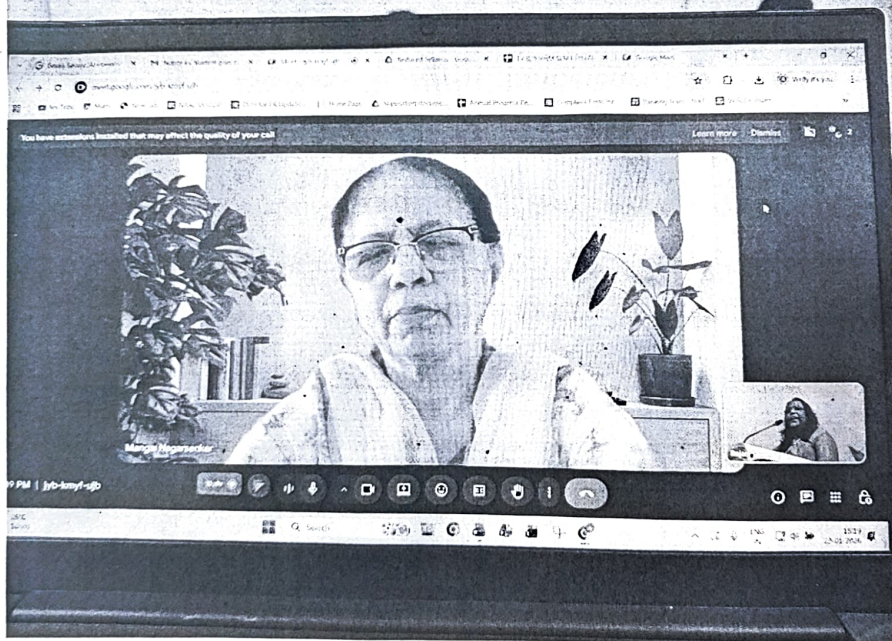
